

JOB TITLE: Maintenance Manager LOCATION: Orange Cove (Plant 1 and/or Plant 2) CLASSIFICATION: Exempt REPORTS TO: VP of Operations

POSITION SUMMARY:

Directly responsible for leading the operation of the maintenance department as well as managing and developing maintenance technicians for our packing facilities located in the Orange Cove area.

Job duties include the planning, organization and execution of the pack facility maintenance as well as the management and coordinating the refrigeration activities of two maintenance departments in separate facilities located in the Orange Cove area.

While performing the duties of this job, the employee frequently works near moving mechanical parts and is frequently exposed to wet and/or humid conditions and extreme cold. The noise level in the work environment is usually moderate.

This job description is intended to describe the general nature of the work-performed in this role. It is not exhaustive of all the job's responsibilities.

This position's basic purpose is to use all available resources to support Booth Ranches' continuous growth and financial success and this role will be utilized to set excellent Maintenance procedures that meet the standards of Booth Ranches LLC.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSABILITIES:

I Planning:

Monitor and maintain both short-term and long-term maintenance schedules starting with daily checklists and extending to multi-year schedules including major overhauls

Implementing a parts inventory system

Develop a personnel educational program on the use and knowledge of all equipment and resources while maintaining compliance with all regulatory Federal and State entities and established policies and procedures to ensure a clean and safe work environment

Ability to work and communicate with other departments as well with department leaders

Workdays are set from Monday thru Saturday but expect the schedule to vary depending on the season

II Organize:

Set up and perform Preventative Maintenance activities

Assist technicians with coordination of building access and obtaining proper equipment/materials as needed

Sourcing and purchase of needed equipment and parts for repairs

Troubleshoot, repair, maintain and calibrate equipment

Administrative activities including policy administration, training and development, recordkeeping, reports, etc

III Manage:

All plant maintenance employees and projects

Investigate and Report accidents or injuries and prepare reports of findings in order to communicate with HR

Comply with all employee safety, food safety and regulatory standards

Create and assign work schedules for the maintenance team and ensure work is completed on time

Build and Develop working relationships with Contractors/vendors in the installation and/or repair of existing equipment

Corrective action items developed from all audits are completed

Shop activities

Work for accuracy and completion

Safety checks, quality checks and other supervisory tasks as needed

Booth Ranches safety programs well as the use of required safety equipment

Advanced knowledge of Single and 3 phase electricity motors

Able to diagnose and repair electrical, pneumatic, hydraulic and automated conveyance systems Proficient in Windows based computer software and systems as well as Microsoft Office (Outlook, Word, Excel) Ability to work well in a team-based environment with limited supervision Must be able to maintain a calm demeanor in high stress situations Excellent attention to detail Good time management skills Able to maintain confidentiality Work well in a team environment Willing to work flexible shifts, weekends, holidays, and extended hours Other duties and responsibilities as Operations evolves
